#### **Course Information**

The purpose of this course is to formalize and extend the mathematics that students learned in the middle grades. The state EOC is given at the end of the course and will count as 25% of your final grade. This course completes the Math I requirement for graduation. I have included some information below that will help you succeed in this course.

## I. Classroom Preparation

- You will need the following items in class with you every day:
  - One (1) 3-ring binder with loose-leaf paper
  - Subject dividers
  - Pencils (Mathematicians don't use pens!)
  - Highlighters and/or colored pencils
  - Fine point dry erase markers
  - 1 Box of Kleenex (for the classroom) -OR- 1 Bottle of Hand Sanitizer

#### II. Classroom Rules & Procedures

- Follow these rules!
  - o BE PROMPT: Arrive to class <u>on time</u> and attend to necessary duties before class begins. Turn in assignments in a timely manner.
  - o BE PREPARED: Always come to class with the items listed above. Have all materials ready to go at the start of class so that they will already be there when you need them.
  - o BE PRODUCTIVE: We have a lot to do in not a lot of time. It is important that we remain on task during the instructional period so that we can cover everything. I would be more than happy to talk about the big game or hear about your weekend in between classes.

  - BE POLITE: The classroom should be a learning environment for <u>everyone</u>. Be respectful to your teacher and your peers. Only one person talks at a time, unless we are doing a group activity. Raise your hand before you speak. Remember the Golden Rule: "Treat others as you wish to be treated."
  - o BE POSITIVE: Always have a positive attitude

**After/Before School Detention:** Students can be assigned before or after school detention for any behavior that is considered inappropriate.

### III. Grading System

Grades will be determined by:

Homework	15%
Classwork	15%
Quizzes	30%
Tests	40%

Homework: Homework is taken up for a grade <u>daily</u>. *All work must be shown in order to receive credit for that homework assignment.* 

**Quizzes:** Quizzes will be given approximately once a week to judge progress in obtaining the unit's objectives.

**Tests:** A unit test will be given at the end of each unit. These tests will be **cumulative** meaning that material from previous units is still fair game. Students will take a cumulative final exam at the end of the course. **Test Corrections:** In the event of an unsatisfactory test grade, test corrections can be completed before or after school with me. **The student is responsible for arranging a date and time for corrections.** All corrections must be completed within 5 days of receiving the graded test.

### IV. Absences

- Students cannot have more than 5 absences in any class period during a semester. A student could be denied credit for this course with absences exceeding this limit.
- If you are absent from class, you are required to make up <u>ALL</u> work including homework, quizzes and tests.
- ♦ You are allowed 10 days for each day absent to make up any missing assignments if the absence is excused. If the absence is unexcused, you are allowed 5 days.
- If you miss test review day (day before the test), know that you will still take the test on test day.

### V. Tardies

- Students are expected to be in class on time and prepared for class. After 3 tardies in a specific course, consequences will begin.
- ♦ 1st block tardies students will be given Friday morning detention
- Other block tardies After School Detention will be given by the teacher
